The tragic accident of October 15, 1985

On October 15, 1985 twenty six JNH students and thirteen guests lost their lives when the roof of the Assembly Hall (South house) suddenly collapsed. These students and their guests were watching the television in the hall when all of a sudden the roof of the building caved in and took the lives of 39 promising young men and injured more than 400. The whole country of Bangladesh was in mourning at this tragedy. One Dhaka Bengali newspaper headline said- “Weep, our countrymen, weep for the loss of your kin”.
